

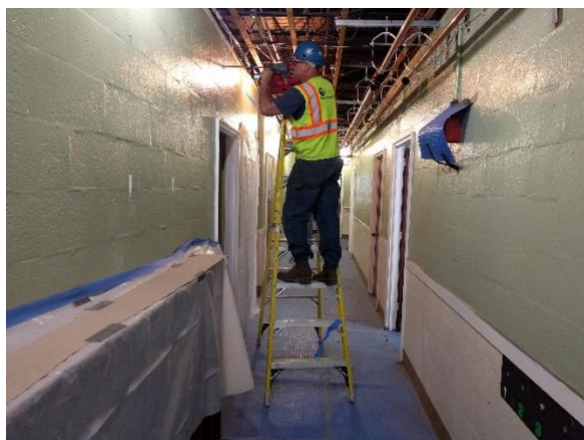
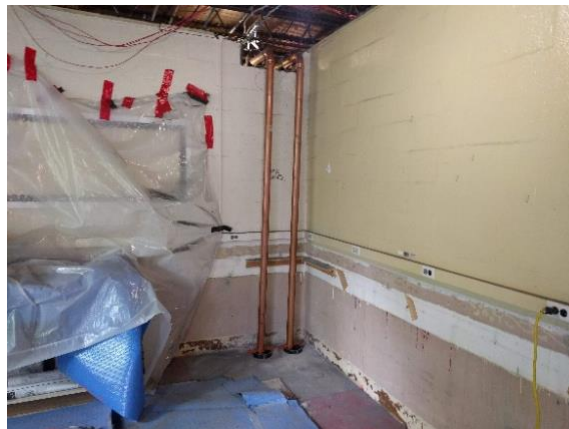

Dear Members and Friends of the Hills Church,

It has been two weeks since we last updated you on the Parish House HVAC and renovation project in which time a lot of progress has been made. A few of the highlights are described below. On the Nursery School level, demolition and asbestos abatement have both been completed, and the air clearance test conducted by Smith and Wessel returned a clean result. This cleared the way for Fraser, the HVAC contractor, to begin their work. They have cored the walls and the slab to allow new piping to run from the basement through the Nursery School to supply heat to the upper floors.



Fraser also installed pipe hangers and hot water mains on this level and began running the hot water piping.

Asbestos abatement and testing were also successfully completed on the second (office) floor.



Following breakdown of the asbestos containment on the second floor, Fraser also began laying out core locations and installing pipe hangers.

On the third floor (Sunday School), spot asbestos abatement is underway.
